## For the teacher:

Teacher presents the vocabulary, either by using visual resources, comparing and contrasting words or using them to refer to people students know.

Teacher cuts the paper slips and puts them in a box or bag.

Students take turns drawing the slips from the bag. They decide if the adjective refers to them or a person they know. They describe themselves/ that person using the verb be, e.g. I am/She is/ You are *intelligent*.

After that, students choose their favorite words and write about themselves or people they know using that vocabulary.
